The appropriations made for the capital 8 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at 9 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are 10 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are 11 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date. 12 SECTION 4. (a) The sums appropriated for the respective 13 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended for 14 15 the purposes of this Act as follows: The sums appropriated in items (1) through (9) shall 16 (1)be expended by the department of education; 17 The sum appropriated in item (10) shall be expended by 18 (2) the department of accounting and general services; 19 (3) The sums appropriated in item (11) shall be expended 20 21 by the department of health; and



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1	(4) The sums appropriated in item (12) shall be expended
2	by the University of Hawaii.
3	(b) The sum appropriated for the capital project set forth
4	in section 2 shall be expended for the purposes of this Act by
5	the department of land and natural resources.
