### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature has received complaints from
 residents about the growing noise pollution and disturbance from
 loud mufflers on motor vehicles, primarily motorcycles. They
 complain that the noise level adversely affects their sleep,
 particularly in the early morning hour or late at night.

6 The legislature finds that the noise may have impacts on
7 public health and safety, as well as peaceful enjoyment and
8 quality of life.

9 The legislature further finds while current laws prohibit 10 vehicle owners from installing mufflers that increase the noise 11 of their vehicle, the penalties are minimal and they do little 12 to deter violators of the current muffler laws, and in fact, 13 violators are known to add the enhanced noise mufflers after 14 they have passed the county vehicle safety check.

15 The purpose of this Act is to enhance the current laws by 16 increasing the fines that may be issued for violation of the 17 loud muffler laws.

1 SECTION 2. Section 291-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§291-23 Penalty. Whoever is convicted of violating any 4 of the provisions of section 291-22 shall be fined not less than 5 \$100 nor more than [<del>\$100.</del>] \$300." 6 SECTION 3. Section 291-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 7 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 8 "(c) Whoever violates this section shall be fined not less 9 than \$100 nor more than [<del>\$100.</del>] \$300." 10 SECTION 4. Section 291-24.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 12 "(b) Any violation of this section shall constitute a 13 violation and shall be enforceable by police officers. The fine 14 for this violation shall be not less than [\$25] \$100 nor more 15 than [<del>\$250</del>] \$300 for each separate offense. Any person who 16 violates the provisions of this section may be issued a summons 17 or citation for such violation." 18 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 20




