## A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL COMMISSION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with article VII, section 9, of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 4 of Act 99, Session Laws of Hawaii
- 5 2019, appropriated \$75,000 in general funds from the fiscal year
- 6 2018-2019 budget for EDN 600 to pay for claims against the State
- 7 or Hawaii state public charter school. This resulted in the
- 8 Hawaii state public charter school being required to use funds
- 9 for the claim payment that were intended for the operation of
- 10 the public charter school and education of public charter school
- 11 students.
- The purpose of this Act is to make an emergency
- 13 appropriation to provide funds to the Hawaii state public
- 14 charter school commission to cover the costs of the claim and
- 15 settlement against the State or Hawaii state public charter
- 16 school.



- 1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 to pay the
- 4 claim and settlement amount pursuant to Miller-Potter v. State
- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the state public
- 7 charter school commission for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
