#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE CAPITOL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 6E-34.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 repealed. 3 ["[§6E-34.5] State capitol; state capitol management 4 committee; established; oversight and management; powers and 5 duties. (a) The oversight and management of the state capitol 6 and its grounds and facilities shall be vested in the state 7 capitol management committee established pursuant to this 8 section. 9 (b) There is established the state capitol management 10 committee, which shall be composed of the following members or 11 their respective designees: 12 (1) The governor's chief of staff; 13 (2) The comptroller; 14 (3) The director of public safety; 15 (4) Two members of the senate as appointed by the

president of the senate;

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1	<del>(5)</del>	Two members of the house of representatives as	
2		appointed by the speaker of the house of	
3		representatives;	
4	<del>(6)</del>	A legislative officer of the senate appointed by the	
5		president of the senate; and	
6	<del>(7)</del>	A legislative officer of the house of representatives	
7		appointed by the speaker of the house of	
8		representatives;	
9	provided that for members appointed pursuant to paragraphs (6)		
10	and (7),	"legislative officer" shall have the same meaning as	
11	that term is defined in section 88-21.		
12	The-	chairperson of the state capitol management committee	
13	<del>shall be</del>	elected by the committee members. The department of	
14	accounting and general services shall provide administrative		
15	support to the state capitol management committee; provided that		
16	the committee shall also receive fiscal analysis support from		
17	the department of budget and finance as the committee deems		
18	appropriate.		
19	<del>(c)</del>	The state capitol management committee shall meet at	
20	times and places as specified by a call of the chairperson or a		
21	majority-	of the committee; provided that the committee shall	

1	meet not less than four times per calendar year. The state		
2	capitol management committee shall prescribe rules, which shall		
3	not be subject to chapter 91, for its own management and		
4	governance. Five members of the committee shall constitute a		
5	quorum, and a quorum may exercise all the power and authority		
6	conferred on the committee.		
7	(d) When a vacancy occurs in the membership of the state		
8	capitol management committee, the respective appointing		
9	authority shall fill the vacancy within fourteen days.		
10	(e) Members of the state capitol management committee		
11	shall serve without pay, but shall be reimbursed for their		
12	actual and necessary expenses, including travel expenses,		
13	incurred in carrying out their duties.		
14	(f) The state capitol management committee shall:		
15	(1) Approve all policies and procedures relating to the		
16	general operation and management of the state capitol		
17	and its grounds and facilities, including parking,		
18	building access, building operation hours, and general		
19	security policies;		
20	(2) Develop and recommend to the legislature capital		
21	improvement, programmatic, and operational priorities		

1		that require fiscal resources to maintain and enhance	
2		the appearance and operation of the state capitol and	
3		its grounds and facilities;	
4	(3)	Review and authorize the repair and maintenance	
5		schedule for the state capitol, its grounds and	
6		facilities, and any other capital improvement projects	
7		relating to the upkeep, renovation, restoration, use,	
8		and maintenance of the state capitol and its grounds	
9		and facilities; and	
10	<del>(4)</del>	Review and authorize, but not execute, the expenditure	
11		of any moneys appropriated to and allocated by the	
12		department of budget and finance, accounting and	
13		general services, or public safety for the state	
14		capitol and its grounds and facilities."]	
15	SECT	ION 2. All policies and procedures established by the	
16	state cap	itol management committee pursuant to section 6E-34.5,	
17	Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall remain in full force and effect		
18	until amended or repealed by the department of accounting and		
19	general s	ervices, governor, senate, or house of representatives,	
20	as applicable.
