A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 183D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§183D-2 Powers and duties of department. The department
 4 shall[+], after considering the advice and recommendations of
 5 the game management advisory commission established pursuant to
 6 section 183D-4.5:
- 7 (1) Manage and administer the wildlife and wildlife
 8 resources of the State;
- 9 (2) Enforce all laws relating to the protecting, taking,
- 10 hunting, killing, propagating, or increasing the
- 11 wildlife within the State and the waters subject to12 its jurisdiction;
- 13 (3) Establish and maintain wildlife propagating facility
 14 or facilities;
- 15 (4) Subject to the provisions of title 12, import wildlife16 for the purpose of propagating and disseminating the

1 same in the State and the waters subject to its 2 jurisdiction; 3 (5) Distribute, free of charge, as the department deems to 4 be in the public interest, game for the purpose of 5 increasing the food supply of the State; provided that 6 when in the discretion of the department the public 7 interest will not be materially interfered with by so 8 doing, the department may propagate and furnish 9 wildlife to private parties, upon such reasonable 10 terms, conditions, and prices as the department may 11 determine; 12 Ascertain, compile, and disseminate, free of charge, (6) 13 information and advice as to the best methods of 14 protecting, propagating, and distributing wildlife in 15 the State and the waters subject to its jurisdiction; 16 (7) Gather and compile information and statistics 17 concerning the area, location, character, and increase 18 and decrease of wildlife in the State; 19 (8) Gather and compile information concerning wildlife 20 recommended for release in different localities, 21 including the care and propagation of wildlife for

1 protective, productive, and aesthetic purposes and 2 other useful information, which the department deems 3 proper; 4 (9) Have the power to manage and regulate all lands which 5 may be set apart as game management areas, public 6 hunting areas, and wildlife sanctuaries; 7 Pursuant to section 183D-65 of this chapter, destroy (10)8 predators deemed harmful to wildlife; 9 (11)Formulate, and from time to time recommend to the 10 governor and legislature, such additional legislation 11 necessary or desirable to implement the objectives of 12 title 12; and 13 (12)Preserve, protect, and promote public hunting." 14 SECTION 2. Section 183D-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 15 amended to read as follows: 16 "§183D-3 Rules. Subject to chapter 91, and after 17 considering the advice and recommendations of the game 18 management advisory commission established pursuant to section 19 183D-4.5, the department shall adopt, amend, and repeal rules: 20 (1)Concerning the preservation, protection, regulation, 21 extension, and utilization of, and conditions for

4	(2)	Protecting, conserving, monitoring, propagating, and
5		harvesting wildlife;
6	(3)	Concerning size limits, bag limits, open and closed
7		seasons, and specifications of hunting gear which may
8		be used or possessed; and
9	(4)	Setting fees for activities permitted under this
10		chapter, unless otherwise provided for by law.
11	The rules may vary from county to county or in any part of the	
12	county and may specify certain days of the week or certain hours	
13	of the day in designating open seasons, except that any fees	
14	established by rule shall be the same for each county. All	
15	rules shall have the force and effect of law."	
16	SECTION 3. Section 183D-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
17	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:	
18	"(a) For the purposes of preserving, protecting,	
19	conserving, and propagating wildlife, the department shall <u>,</u>	
20	after considering the advice and recommendations from the game	
21	managemen	t advisory commission established pursuant to section

1 <u>183D-4.5</u>, establish, maintain, manage, and operate game
2 management areas, wildlife sanctuaries, and public hunting areas
3 on land under its control and, as it deems desirable, enter into
4 agreements for taking control of privately owned lands for those
5 purposes."

6 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

Department of Land and Natural Resources; Game Management Advisory Commission

Description:

Requires the department of land and natural resources to consider the advice and recommendations of the game management advisory commission in carrying out its duties and powers; adopting, amending, or repealing rules; and in its managements of game areas, wildlife sanctuaries, and public hunting areas.

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
