A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that behavior analysis
- 2 means the design, implementation, and evaluation of
- 3 instructional and environmental modifications to produce
- 4 socially significant improvements in human behavior. The
- 5 practice of behavior analysis includes the empirical
- 6 identification of functional relations between behavior and
- 7 environmental factors, known as functional assessment and
- 8 analysis, as well as the use of contextual factors, motivating
- 9 operations, antecedent stimuli, positive reinforcement and other
- 10 consequences to help people develop new behaviors, increase or
- 11 decrease existing behaviors, and emit behaviors under specific
- 12 environmental conditions.
- 13 The legislature further finds that Act 199, Session Laws of
- 14 Hawaii 2015, established licensing requirements for behavior
- 15 analysts. Licensing of behavior analysis services was made
- 16 concurrent with mandated insurance coverage for the diagnosis
- 17 and treatment of autism spectrum disorders.

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- 1 The legislature additionally finds that many students
- 2 enrolled in department of education schools would benefit from
- 3 the expansion of behavior analysis services throughout the
- 4 State's public school system, including students with autism
- 5 spectrum disorders.
- 6 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to fund behavior
- 7 analysis services performed by licensed behavior analysts for
- 8 public school students.
- 9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$20,000,000 or so
- 11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and
- 12 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 13 year 2020-2021 for the department of education to provide
- 14 behavior analysis services performed by licensed behavior
- 15 analysts for public school students.
- 16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 17 of education for the purposes of this Act. The department of
- 18 education may contract with any licensed behavior analyst for
- 19 the purposes of this Act.

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
