A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NOISE CONTROL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that section 11-46-1, SECTION 1. 2 Hawaii Administrative Rules, states, "It is the purpose of this 3 chapter to define the maximum permissible sound levels, and to 4 provide for the prevention, control, and abatement of noise 5 pollution in the State from the following excessive noise 6 sources: stationary noise sources; and equipment related to 7 agricultural, construction, and industrial activities. It is 8 also the purpose of this chapter to establish noise quality 9 standards to protect public health and welfare, and to prevent 10 the significant degradation of the environment and quality of 11 life." The legislature recognizes that the department of health 12 has the responsibility to address excessive noise issues and the impacts of excessive noise in the State. 13

14 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of 15 health, in collaboration with the Federal Aviation 16 Administration and the department of transportation, to conduct

a study on the impacts of aviation noise on residents of the
 State.

3 SECTION 2. (a) Pursuant to section 11-46-1, Hawaii Administrative Rules, the department of health, in collaboration 4 5 with the Federal Aviation Administration and the department of 6 transportation, shall conduct a study to determine the impacts 7 of aviation noise on the health and welfare of residents of the 8 State. Public meetings shall be held during the course of the 9 study to obtain the community's input on the aviation noise 10 issue.

(b) The department of health, in collaboration with the
Federal Aviation Administration and the department of
transportation, shall report its findings and recommendations,
including any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later
than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session
of 2020.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$100,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 to conduct a study to determine the impacts of aviation noise on the health and welfare of residents of the State.
