### A BILL FOR AN ACT

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to part XIII, subpart E, to be
3	appropriately designated and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§11-</u> Contributions during legislative session
5	prohibited; fundraising. (a) No entity, firm, association,
6	corporation, nonprofit corporation, S corporation, limited
7	liability company, general partnership, limited partnership, or
8	lobbyist shall make a monetary or in-kind contribution to a
9	candidate who is a member of the legislature or make a loan to a
10	candidate who is a member of the legislature or to that
11	candidate's candidate committee or noncandidate committee during
12	any regular legislative session, during the five calendar days
13	following adjournment sine die, and during any special session.
14	(b) No candidate who is a member of the legislature shall
15	knowingly solicit or accept a contribution from a lobbyist or
16	person by whom the lobbyist is retained or employed or on whose
17	behalf the lobbyist appears or works during any regular

Prohibits campaign contributions from certain entities to members of the legislature during the legislative session, for five days following adjournment sine die, and during a special session. Prohibits a member of the legislature from knowingly soliciting or accepting a contribution from a lobbyist or a lobbyist's principal during a legislative session, for five days following adjournment sine die, and during a special session. Prohibits fundraisers for any member of the legislature to be held during any regular legislative session, for five calendar days following adjournment sine die, and during a special session. Takes effect on 1/1/2020.
