## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

10	(2) Identifying victims of sex trafficking;		
11	(3) Effects of sex trafficking on a victim's social,

13	(4) Strategies to assist in the prevention of sex		
14	trafficking of children;		
15	(5) Trauma-informed strategies for responding to victims		
16	of sex trafficking;
