A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH CARE INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, according to the 1
- 2 department of health, cancer is the second leading cause of
- death among Hawaii residents, claiming more than two thousand 3
- 4 two hundred Hawaii residents each year. The legislature further
- 5 finds that cancer patients should have full access to effective
- 6 treatment options at early stages of their illnesses.
- The purpose of this Act is to prohibit health insurers that 7
- cover treatment for stage two through stage five cancer from 8
- 9 requiring an insured diagnosed with stage two through stage five
- 10 cancer to undergo step therapy prior to covering the insured for
- 11 the drug prescribed by the insured's health care provider, under
- 12 certain conditions.
- SECTION 2. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13
- 14 amended by adding a new section to part I of article 10A to be
- appropriately designated and to read as follows: 15

- stage five cancer. (a) No individual accident and health or 17

18	treatment of stage two through stage five cancer shall require a
19	subscriber or member who is diagnosed with a stage two through
20	stage five cancer to undergo step therapy prior to covering the

1	drug prescribed by the subscriber's or member's health care
2	provider if the prescribed drug is:
3	(1) An investigational new drug; or
4	(2) A prescription drug:
5	(A) That is approved by the United States Food and
6	Drug Administration;
7	(B) Whose use is consistent with best practices for
8	the treatment of the cancer in its respective
9	stage; and
10	(C) That is listed on the mutual benefit society's
11	prescription drug formulary.
12	(b) For the purposes of this section:
13	"Investigational new drug" has the same meaning as provided
14	under 21 Code of Federal Regulations section 312.3.
15	"Step therapy" means a protocol that requires a subscriber
16	or member to use a prescription drug or sequence of prescription
17	drugs, other than the drug that the subscriber's or member's
18	health care provider recommends for the subscriber's or member's
19	treatment, before the mutual benefit society provides coverage
20	for the recommended prescription drug."
