### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VISION ZERO.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that vision zero is a
 traffic safety program that seeks to end traffic deaths and
 serious injuries.

The legislature further finds that the idea originated in 4 Sweden, which adopted vision zero as a national policy in 1997 5 6 and by 2013 had achieved a record low of road accident fatalities. In 2000, the state of Washington became the first 7 8 in the United States to adopt the program and to set an aggressive goal of zero traffic deaths and serious injuries by 9 2030. Washington reported that the state averaged twenty-two 10 fewer traffic fatalities and eighty fewer serious injuries each 11 12 year from 2002 to 2011.

13 The legislature finds that many of the country's large.
14 cities, including New York, Boston, Los Angeles, and Chicago,
15 have adopted vision zero or similar programs. The Federal
16 Highway Administration is also committed to eliminating traffic

fatalities and serious injuries, adopting a policy called 1 "toward zero deaths." 2 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of 3 transportation to adopt and implement a vision zero program. 4 SECTION 2. (a) The department of transportation shall 5 implement a vision zero program by July 1, 2020. 6 (b) The goal of the vision zero program shall be to 7 eliminate traffic fatalities and serious injuries in Hawaii by 8 9 2030. The department of transportation, in conjunction with 10 (C) the counties, shall take the necessary steps to implement the 11 12 program. The director of transportation may adopt rules 13 (d) pursuant to chapter 91 for the purposes of this Act. 14 (e) No later than twenty days prior to the convening of 15 each regular session, the department shall submit a report to 16 the legislature on the progress made toward the goal of 17 eliminating traffic fatalities and serious injuries. 18 19 SECTION 3.
