### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the rapid growth and
- 2 widespread use of unregulated unmanned aircraft systems has
- 3 created a potential risk to people and property in Hawaii.
- 4 Congress, in creating the FAA Reauthorization Act of 2018
- 5 (Public Law 115-254), recognized these safety and other
- 6 concerns, including privacy protection, reporting of
- 7 unauthorized operation, illegal use over wildfires, enforcement,
- 8 electronic self-identification of unmanned aircraft systems, and
- 9 stiff penalties for interfering with public safety. Congress
- 10 has directed the Federal Aviation Administration and the
- 11 Department of Transportation Inspector General to assess and
- 12 report on these issues, intending to develop guidance for
- 13 compliance best practices at a national level.
- 14 While federal action will establish uniform responses to
- 15 these issues and preempt the need for equivalent state or local
- 16 unmanned aircraft systems registration and operating law, we
- 17 believe it is necessary to create Hawaii law which enables

3	SECTION 2. Chapter 711, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is								
4	amended by adding three new sections to be appropriately								
5	designated and to read as follows:								
6	"§711- Unauthorized use of unmanned aircraft in the								
7	first deg	ree. (1) A person commits the offense of unauthorized							
8	use of unmanned aircraft in the first degree if the person								
9	intentionally or knowingly:								
10	<u>(a)</u>	Equips, alters, or attaches an unmanned aircraft with							
11		a dangerous or deadly weapon or deploys an unmanned							
12		aircraft that is equipped with a dangerous or deadly							
13		weapon; or							
14	(b)	Operates an unmanned aircraft with the intent to use							
15		the unmanned aircraft or anything attached to it to							
16		cause harm to a person or property.							
17	(2)	For purposes of this section "dangerous or deadly							
18	weapon" s	hall include those items listed in section 134-51.							
19	(3)	Unauthorized use of unmanned aircraft in the first							
20	degree is	a misdemeanor.							

1	§711- Unauthorized use of unmanned aircraft in the							
2	second degree. (1) A person commits the offense of							
3	unauthorized use of unmanned aircraft in the second degree if							
4	the person intentionally or knowingly operates an unmanned							
5	aircraft:							
6	(a) In a manner that creates a hazardous or physically							
7	offensive condition;							
8	(b) In violation of any federal or state law; or							
9	(c) In a reckless or careless manner.							
10	(2) Unauthorized use of unmanned aircraft in the second							
11	degree is a petty misdemeanor.							
12	§711- Unauthorized use of unmanned aircraft in the third							
13	degree. (1) A person commits the offense of unauthorized use							
14	of unmanned aircraft in the third degree if the person							
15	recklessly operates an unmanned aircraft in violation of Federal							
16	Aviation Administration rules.							
17	(2) Unauthorized use of unmanned aircraft in the third							
18	degree is a petty misdemeanor if the defendant persists after							
19	reasonable warning or request to desist. Otherwise,							
20	unauthorized use of unmanned aircraft in the third degree is a							
21	violation."

1	SECTION 3. Section 711-1100, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is							
2	amended by adding five new definitions to be appropriately							
3	inserted and to read as follows:							
4	""Model aircraft" means an unmanned aircraft that is:							
5	(1) Capable of sustained flight in the atmosphere;							
6	(2) Flown within visual line of sight of the person							
7	operating the aircraft; and							
8	(3) Flown for hobby or recreational purposes.							
9	"Public unmanned aircraft system" means an unmanned							
10	aircraft system that meets the qualifications and conditions							
11	required for operation of a public aircraft as defined in title							
12	49 United States Code section 40102(a).							
13	"Small unmanned aircraft" means an unmanned aircraft							
14	weighing less than fifty-five pounds, including everything that							
15	is on board or otherwise attached to the aircraft.							
16	"Unmanned aircraft" means an aircraft that is operated							
17	without the possibility of direct human intervention from within							
18	or on the aircraft.							
19	"Unmanned aircraft system" means an unmanned aircraft and							
20	associated elements, including communication links and							
21	components that control the unmanned aircraft, that are required

1	for	the	pilot	in	command	to	operate	safely	and	efficiently	in

- 2 the national airspace."
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
