A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CESSPOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 132, Session
2	Laws of Hawaii 2018, established the cesspool conversion working
3	group to develop a long-range, comprehensive plan for conversion
4	of cesspools statewide by 2050 and commissioned a statewide
5	study of sewage contamination in nearshore marine areas to
6	further supplement studies and reports conducted by the
7	department of health on cesspools. The working group convened
8	in 2018 and has been diligently working to meet the objectives.
9	set out in Act 132; however, the working group needs additional
10	time and resources to complete its work.
11	The purpose of this Act is to:
12	(1) Extend various reporting deadlines and the sunset date
13	of the cesspool conversion working group; and
14	(2) Appropriate additional funds for the conduct of the
15	comprehensive statewide study of sewage contamination
16	in nearshore marine areas and for research and

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1 technical assistance necessary for completion of the 2 comprehensive cesspool conversion plan. 3 SECTION 2. Act 132, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, section 4 2, is amended as follows: 5 1. By amending subsection (e) to read: 6 "(e) The cesspool conversion working group shall submit an 7 interim report of its preliminary findings and recommendations, 8 including proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than 9 December 31, [2019,] 2021, and shall submit a final report, 10 including findings, recommendations, and any proposed 11 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of [2021.] 2023." 12 13 2. By amending subsection (g) to read: 14 "(g) The working group shall be dissolved on January 14, 15 [2021.] 2023." SECTION 3. Act 132, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, section 16 17 3, is amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 18 The university of Hawaii water resources research 19 center and the department of health shall submit a report of 20 their findings and recommendations, including any proposed

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- 1 legislation, to the cesspool conversion working group and the
- 2 legislature no later than October 1, [2019.] 2021."
- 3 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000 or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for the
- 6 university of Hawaii water resources research center, in
- 7 cooperation and consultation with the department of health, to
- 8 conduct a comprehensive statewide study of sewage contamination
- 9 in nearshore marine areas.
- 10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the university of
- 11 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,000,000 or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for the
- 15 department of health to conduct research or gather technical
- 16 assistance on other issues as identified by the cesspool
- 17 conversion working group in completing its comprehensive
- 18 cesspool conversion plan.
- 19 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 20 health for the purposes of this Act.

1 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed

2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
