A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CESSPOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 132, Session
2	Laws of Hawaii 2018, established the cesspool conversion working
3	group to develop a long-range, comprehensive plan for conversion
4	of cesspools statewide by 2050 and commissioned a statewide
5	study of sewage contamination in nearshore marine areas to
6	further supplement studies and reports conducted by the
7	department of health on cesspools. The working group convened
8	in 2018 and has been diligently working to meet the objectives
9	set out in Act 132; however, the working group needs additional
10	time and resources to complete its work.
11	The purpose of this Act is to:
12	(1) Extend various reporting deadlines and the sunset date
13	of the cesspool conversion working group; and
14	(2) Extend the lapse date for funds appropriated to
15	conduct a comprehensive statewide study of sewage
16	contamination in nearshore marine areas and for
17	research and technical assistance necessary for

- 1 completion of the comprehensive cesspool conversion
- 2 plan.
- 3 SECTION 2. Act 132, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, is
- 4 amended by adding a new section to read as follows:
- 5 "SECTION 6. Moneys appropriated pursuant to sections 4 and
- 6 5 of this Act shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for
- 7 which the moneys have been appropriated; provided that any
- 8 moneys appropriated pursuant to sections 4 and 5 of this Act
- 9 that are unencumbered as of June 30, 2020, shall lapse on that
- 10 date."
- 11 SECTION 3. Act 132, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, section
- 12 2, is amended as follows:
- 1. By amending subsection (e) to read:
- "(e) The cesspool conversion working group shall submit an
- 15 interim report of its preliminary findings and recommendations,
- 16 including proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than
- 17 December 31, [2019,] 2020, and shall submit a final report,
- 18 including findings, recommendations, and any proposed
- 19 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 20 to the convening of the regular session of [2021.] 2022."
- 21 2. By amending subsection (g) to read:

- 1 "(g) The working group shall be dissolved on January 14,
- **2** [2021.] 2022."
- 3 SECTION 4. Act 132, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, section
- 4 3, is amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 5 "(b) The university of Hawaii water resources research
- 6 center and the department of health shall submit a report of
- 7 their findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 8 legislation, to the cesspool conversion working group and the
- 9 legislature no later than October 1, [2019.] 2020."
- 10 SECTION 5. Act 132, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, is
- 11 amended by amending section 6 to read as follows:
- "SECTION [6.] 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1,
- 13 2018."
- 14 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2100.
