A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

The legislature finds that invasive species can 1 wreak havoc on Hawaii's fragile ecosystem, environment, and 2 agricultural lands. The legislature further finds that 3 intrastate commerce and the transportation of plants has 4 resulted in a significant and growing problem in the county of 5 Maui with: 6 7 Eleutherodactylus coqui, commonly known as "coqui (1)frogs"; 8 9 Wasmannia auropunctata, commonly known as "little fire (2) 10 ants"; Hypothenemus hampei, commonly known as "coffee borer 11 (3) 12 beetles" or "coffee berry borers"; 13 (4)Dynastinae, commonly known as "rhinoceros beetles"; Angiostrongylus cantonensis, commonly known as "rat 14 (5) 15 lungworm disease"; and Chital, commonly known as "axis deer." 16 (6)

- 1 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to
- 2 substantially reduce and eradicate the problem of invasive
- 3 species in the county of Maui.
- 4 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 6 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the
- 7 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 8 2020-2021 for activities relating to the substantial reduction
- 9 and eradication of invasive species in the county of Maui
- 10 pursuant to this Act.
- 11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 12 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
