PART I

RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL LAND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 2 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 119, Session 3 Laws of Hawaii 2015, as amended and renumbered by Act 124,
- zawa or nawari zoro, wa ameriasa ana zonamosioa a, nos zin,
- 4 Session Laws of Hawaii 2016, appropriated, in item A-8.03 of
- 5 section 47, \$31,500,000 in general obligation bond funds to
- $\mathbf{6}$ acquire various agricúltural lands. Pursuant to section 90 of
- 7 Act 119, unencumbered funds for capital improvement project
- ${f 8}$ appropriations for that biennium lapsed on June 30, 2018.
- 9 However, pursuant to authority granted to the department of
- 10 accounting and general services by the State of Hawaii
- 11 accounting manual, volume I, part 400, the lapse date for the
- 12 item A-8.03 appropriation was extended to June 30, 2019.
- 13 The legislature further finds that the State requires an
- 14 additional year to complete the purchase authorized by item
- 15 A-8.03.

- 16 The purpose of this part is to extend the lapse date of the
- 17 appropriation made by item A-8.03 by one year.



1	SECTION 2. Act 119, Session Laws of Hawaii 2015, as
2	amended and renumbered by Act 124, Session Laws of Hawaii 2016,
3	is amended by amending section 90 to read as follows:
4	"SECTION 90. Any provision of this Act to the contrary
5	notwithstanding, the appropriations made for capital improvement
6	projects authorized under this Act shall not lapse at the end of
7	the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is made;
8	provided that all appropriations made to be expended in fiscal
9	biennium 2015-2017 which are unencumbered as of June 30, 2018,
10	shall lapse as of that date; and provided further that this
11	lapsing date shall not apply to:
12	(1) Appropriations for projects where the means of funding
13	is the state educational facilities improvement
14	special fund, where such appropriations have been
15	authorized for more than three years for the
16	construction or acquisition of public school
17	facilities; [and]
18	(2) Non-general fund appropriations for projects described
19	in section 47 of this Act where such appropriations
20	have been deemed necessary to qualify for federal aid
