BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. (a) The following positions are established		
2	within the agricultural resource management division of the		
3	department of agriculture:		
4	(1) full-time equivalent (FTE) irrigation		
5	district manager position (SR21);		
6	(2) full-time equivalent (FTE) irrigation		
7	system worker II positions (BC07); and		
8	(3) full-time equivalent (FTE) office		
9	assistant III position (SR08).		
10	(b) The portions of the east Kauai irrigation system		
11	operated and maintained by the east Kauai water users'		
12	cooperative as of July 1, 2019, may be placed under the		
13	operational authority of the department of agriculture until		
14	such time that:		
15	(1) The department of agriculture's adoption of rules		
16	pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for

1 the operation and maintenance of the system is 2 completed; or 3 (2) A determination is made that the system can be 4 appropriately operated and maintained pursuant to 5 chapters 167 and 168, Hawaii Revised Statutes. 6 Until the system is transferred to the appropriate program, the 7 operational authority shall not be governed by chapter 167 or 168, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for acreage assessment or water 8 9 delivery fees. The department of agriculture may contract with the east Kauai water users' cooperative to authorize the 10 11 cooperative to bill and collect any fees from the users of the

12 irrigation system and to enter into any and all contracts 13 necessary to operate and maintain the system, including 14 operation and maintenance contracts while positions are filled. 15 All fees collected by the east Kauai water users' cooperative 16 shall be deposited into the general fund of the State by the 17 department of agriculture.

(c) The three-year water licensing deadline may be
extended for up to two years; provided that the applicant
demonstrates significant progress in the permit application
process.

1 SECTION 2. All appropriations, records, equipment, 2 machines, files, supplies, contracts, books, papers, documents, maps, and other personal property heretofore made, used, 3 acquired, or held by the east Kauai water users' cooperative 4 5 relating to the functions transferred to the department of 6 agriculture shall be listed in a full accounting to the 7 department of agriculture with the functions to which they 8 relate. SECTION 3. The director of finance is authorized to issue 9 10 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much 11 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof 12 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2019-2020 13 for the purpose of assisting the department of agriculture's 14 agricultural resource management division with plans, designs, 15 land acquisition, and equipment to increase state irrigation 16 system capacity statewide, including: 17 (1)for planning; \$ 18 (2) \$ for design; 19 (3) \$ for land acquisition; and 20 (4) \$ for equipment.
