A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that under existing law,
- 2 continuing education requirements for naturopathic physicians
- 3 only include courses approved by professional associations or
- 4 organizations approved by the board of naturopathic medicine.
- 5 Certain courses, which are otherwise accredited by a
- 6 naturopathic medical school or another licensing board, are
- 7 therefore not acceptable in Hawaii unless approved by a board-
- 8 approved organization. This has resulted in significant amounts
- 9 of additional work for these board-approved organizations and
- 10 confusion amongst Hawaii's naturopathic physicians regarding
- 11 acceptable continuing education courses.
- 12 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to clarify the list
- 13 of acceptable institutions or organizations that can meet the
- 14 continuing education requirements needed by naturopathic
- 15 physicians for license renewal.

1	SECTION 2. Section 455-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by amending the definition of "continuing education		
3	courses" to read as follows:		
4	""Continuing education courses" means courses approved by		
5	state or province naturopathic licensing board; university,		
6	college, or institution of naturopathic medicine program		
7	accredited by the Council on Naturopathic Medical Education; or		
8	a professional association or organization representing a		
9	licensed profession whose program objectives are related to		
10	naturopathic medicine; provided that the professional		
11	association or organization is approved by the board."		
12	SECTION 3. Section 455-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
13	amended by amending subsection (f) to read as follows:		
14	"(f) Prior to December 31 of each odd-numbered year, each		
15	licensee shall:		
16	(1) Complete the renewal form prescribed by the board and		
17	certify that the licensee has complied with the		
18	continuing education requirement of this section for		
19	the applicable renewal period; and		
20	(2) Submit evidence of completion of the continuing		
21	education courses taken during the applicable renewal		

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1	period	to the board, including but not limited to
2	certifi	icates of completion. At a minimum,
3	documer	ntation shall contain the following information
4	(A) Na	ame of the licensee;
5	(B) Ti	tle of the continuing education course taken;
6	(C) Da	ate that the continuing education course was
7	ta	aken;
8	(D) Na	ame of the state or province licensing board;
9	ur	niversity, college, or institution of
10	na	aturopathic medicine program; or professional
11	as	ssociation or organization that approved the
12	co	ontinuing education course;
13	(E) Nu	umber of hours for the course; and
14	(F) Nu	umber of hours for the course in pharmacology."
15	SECTION 4.	New statutory material is underscored.
16	SECTION 5.	This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
