A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROSTITUTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the current language
- 2 used to describe the offense of advancing prostitution is overly
- 3 broad. The purpose of this Act is to clarify that a person
- 4 advancing prostitution includes persons who harm or abuse a
- 5 prostitute but not persons offering help or assistance to
- 6 prostitutes facing harm or danger while engaging in
- 7 prostitution.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 712-1201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:
- 10 "(1) A person "advances prostitution" if, acting other
- 11 than as a prostitute or a patron of a prostitute, the person
- 12 knowingly causes or aids a person to commit or engage in
- 13 prostitution, procures or solicits patrons for prostitution,
- 14 provides persons for prostitution purposes, permits premises to
- 15 be regularly used for prostitution purposes, operates or assists
- 16 in the operation of a house of prostitution or a prostitution
- 17 enterprise, or engages in any other conduct that is harmful or

- 1 abusive to a prostitute and designed to institute, aid, or
- 2 facilitate an act or enterprise of prostitution. A person shall
- 3 not be deemed to be "advancing prostitution" if the person
- 4 assists or offers to assist a prostitute who is being subjected
- 5 to harm or abuse from another person."
- 6 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
