A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR PRESIDENT THEODORE ROOSEVELT HIGH SCHOOL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, founded in 1930 and 2 situated in Makiki on the island of Oahu, President Theodore Roosevelt high school has grown to serve an enrollment of more 3 4 than one thousand four hundred students. The school's existing 5 gymnasium and music building were constructed over fifty years 6 ago and do not meet current department of education standards. 7 The legislature provided funding for plans and design for a master plan for a new gymnasium, new music building, and 8 additional on-site parking in Act 106, Session Laws of Hawaii 9 10 The final master plan, DOE Job No. Q22000-13, dated 11 December 23, 2014, presented the preferred master plan for: 12 A new gymnasium over a one-level parking structure at 13 the site of the existing gymnasium; and
- 14 (2) A new two-story music building and repurposing of the existing music building.

1	The purpose of this Act is to provide funding for the
2	implementation of the master plan for the new music facilities
3	for President Theodore Roosevelt high school.
4	SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
5	general obligation bonds in the sum of \$9,850,000 or so much
6	thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
7	as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2019-2020
8	for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects as
9	follows:
10	President Theodore Roosevelt high school
11	Plans, design, construction, and equipment for new
12	music facilities with classrooms, practice rooms,
13	teacher offices, and other related facilities; ground
14	and site improvements; and appurtenances.
15	Plans \$250,000
16	Design \$1,500,000
17	Construction \$7,600,000
18	Equipment \$500,000
19	Total funding \$9,850,000
20	SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the capital
21	improvement projects set forth in section 2 of this Act shall be

- 1 expended by the department of education for the purposes of this
- 2 Act.

- 3 SECTION 4. The appropriation made for the capital
- 4 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
- 5 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
- 6 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
- 7 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
