### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 Except as provided in section 387-9 and this section, "(a) 4 every employer shall pay to each employee employed by the 5 employer, wages at the rate of not less than: 6 (1)\$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003; \$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006; (2) 8 (3) \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007; 9 \$7.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2015; (4) 10 (5) \$8.50 per hour beginning January 1, 2016; 11 (6) \$9.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2017; [and] 12 \$10.10 per hour beginning January 1, 2018[-]; and (7) 13 \$12.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2022." (8) 14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
