A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the invasion of
- 2 Hawai'i by insects, disease-bearing organisms, snakes, weeds, and
- 3 other pests is the single greatest threat to the State's economy
- 4 and natural environment and to the health and lifestyle of the
- 5 people of Hawai'i. Pests already cause millions of dollars in
- 6 crop losses, the extinction of native species, the destruction
- 7 of native forests, and the spread of disease, but many more
- 8 harmful pests now threaten to invade Hawai'i and cause more
- 9 damage. Stopping the influx of new pests and containing their
- 10 spread are essential to the State's current and future well-
- 11 being.
- 12 The legislature further recognizes the efforts made by the
- 13 department of land and natural resources' division of forestry
- 14 and wildlife, Hawai'i branch, and the Big Island invasive species
- 15 committee to control high-threat invasive species throughout
- 16 Hawai'i county, especially efforts in Hawai'i county to control
- 17 miconia, a fast-growing weedy tree that can increase erosion and

- 1 landslides due to its shallow root system. Large infestations
- 2 of miconia are on the windward side of Hawai'i island with a
- 3 smaller population on the leeward side, which pose a threat to
- 4 the local environment, cultural practices, and economy.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to provide funds to establish
- 6 invasive species technician positions for the department of land
- 7 and natural resources' division of forestry and wildlife in
- 8 Hawai'i county to control invasive species, like miconia, from
- 9 negatively impacting the environment and economy.
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000 or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the
- 13 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 14 2020-2021 to establish five permanent full-time equivalent (5.0
- 15 FTE) invasive species technician positions at the department of
- 16 land and natural resources' division of forestry and wildlife,
- 17 Hawai'i branch, to address invasive plants and animals in Hawai'i
- 18 county.
- 19 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 20 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
