# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general  
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the  
4 sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for  
5 fiscal year 2020-2021 for the Hawaii health systems corporation  
6 to improve the health care services at Hilo medical center;  
7 provided that the funds shall be used for the following:

8 (1) Costs associated with recruiting and employing two  
9 additional cardiologists while they establish their  
10 invasive cardiology practice;

11 (2) Costs of support staff required to support the  
12 cardiology practice;

13 (3) Initial training of catheterization lab, intensive  
14 care unit, and radiology staff;

15 (4) Purchasing of inventory of medical devices and  
16 medications used for interventional cardiology  
17 procedures;



- 1 (5) Purchasing of medical equipment for the cardiac
- 2 catheterization lab and intensive care unit;
- 3 (6) Purchasing of diagnostic laboratory equipment; and
- 4 (7) Initial costs of a certified lab technician.

5 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii  
6 health systems corporation for the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
