A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LAND DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that in January 2016, the Hawaii county planning director and the chairperson of the board 2 3 of land and natural resources signed a statement of understanding to enter into a collaborative process for the 4 5 redevelopment of the Banyan Drive peninsula because it consisted 6 of real property that was underutilized or in disrepair. 7 Pursuant to chapter 53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the county of 8 Hawaii created a local redevelopment agency, the Banyan Drive 9 Hawaii redevelopment agency, to work toward improving the Banyan 10 Drive redevelopment area, as defined by the Hawaii county 11 council, through a coordinated revitalization effort via the 12 adoption and implementation of a master urban redevelopment 13 plan. A conceptual master plan for redevelopment of the Banyan 14 Drive redevelopment area was developed between May and October 15 of 2016, which established a starting place for the formation of 16 the redevelopment plan. However, in order for the redevelopment 17 plan to be further developed, funding is needed to conduct the

1	necessary environmental impact studies and other studies
2	required pursuant to chapter 343, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
3	The purpose of this Act is to:
4	(1) Require the department of land and natural resources
5	to allocate ten per cent of revenues collected from
6	commercial properties within the Banyan Drive
7	redevelopment area to the Banyan Drive Hawaii
8	redevelopment agency; and
9	(2) Appropriate funds to the Banyan Drive Hawaii
10	redevelopment agency for conducting environmental
11	impact statements that are necessary to complete the
12	agency's redevelopment plan for the Banyan Drive
13	redevelopment area.
14	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the
15	department of land and natural resources shall allocate ten per
16	cent of the revenues collected each year in rents for leases,
17	licenses, and permits from any commercial property within the
18	Banyan Drive redevelopment area, as defined by the Hawaii county
19	council, to the Banyan Drive Hawaii redevelopment agency within
20	the county of Hawaii.

2	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and
4	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
5	year 2020-2021 to the Banyan Drive Hawaii redevelopment agency
6	within the county of Hawaii for conducting environmental impact

18	provided further that no funds shall be made available under

\$250,000 for fiscal year 2020-2021 for the purpose for which
these sums are appropriated.

3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department4 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
