A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONSERVATION DISTRICTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION	1.	Section	183C-4,	Hawaii	Revised	Statutes,	is

- amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) The department shall adopt rules governing the use of
- 4 land within the boundaries of the conservation district that are
- 5 consistent with the conservation of necessary forest growth, the
- 6 conservation and development of land and natural resources
- 7 adequate for present and future needs, and the conservation and
- 8 preservation of open space areas for public use and
- 9 enjoyment[-]; provided that no waste or disposal facility shall
- 10 be located in a conservation district except in emergency
- 11 circumstances where it may be necessary to mitigate significant
- 12 risks to public safety and health. No use except a
- 13 nonconforming use as defined in section 183C-5, shall be made
- 14 within the conservation district unless the use is in accordance
- 15 with a zoning rule. For purposes of this subsection, "waste or
- 16 disposal facility" means any transfer station or landfill as
- 17 defined in section 340A-1, open dump as defined in section



- 1 342H-1, solid waste reduction facility or waste reduction
- 2 facility as defined in section 342G-1, disposal facility, or any
- 3 other facility for the disposal of solid waste that is required
- 4 by law to obtain a permit from the department of health."
- 5 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
