A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHARTER SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 302D-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:
3	"(a) Beginning with fiscal year 2012-2013, and each fiscal
4	year thereafter, the non-facility general fund per-pupil funding
5	request for charter school students shall be the same as the
6	general fund per-pupil amount to the department in the most
7	recently approved executive budget recommendation for the
8	department and shall be based upon reasonable projected
9	enrollment figures for all charter schools. The general fund
10	per-pupil request for each regular education and special
11	education student shall:
12	(1) Include all general fund regular education cost
13	categories, including comprehensive school support
14	services, but excluding special education services,
15	adult education, and the after-school plus program;
16	provided that these services are provided and funded
17	by the department; [and]

1	(2)	Exclude fringe benefit costs and debt service $[-]$; and	
2	(3)	Exclude student transportation costs; provided that	
3		the commission shall determine the qualifications for	
4		school transportation and any fee or payment for	
5		students.	
6	(b)	[Fringe] Student transportation costs for charter	
7	school stu	dents and fringe benefit costs for charter school	
8	employees,	regardless of the payroll system utilized by a	
9	charter sc	hool, shall be included in the department of budget	
10	and finance's annual budget request. No student transportation		
11	costs or f	ringe benefit costs shall be charged directly to or	
12	deducted f	rom the charter school per-pupil allocations.	
13	The l	egislature shall make an appropriation based upon the	
14	budget req	uest; provided that the legislature may make	
15	additional	appropriations for facility and other costs.	
16	The g	overnor, pursuant to chapter 37, may impose	
17	restrictio	ns or reductions on charter school appropriations	
18	similar to	those imposed on department schools."

Charter Schools; Per-pupil Funding Requests; Student Transportation Costs; Department of Budget and Finance Annual Budget

Requires student transportation costs for charter school students to be included in the department of budget and finance's annual budget request rather than including it in the per-pupil funding amount.
