## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that some state positions
- 2 have remained vacant for decades. By eliminating those vacant
- 3 state positions, the State can forecast an accurate budget with
- 4 less wasteful spending. The purpose of this Act is to require
- 5 that each fiscal year all departments, agencies, and other
- 6 instrumentalities of the State identify positions that have been
- 7 vacant for five or more years and eliminate those positions from
- 8 their budget request for the next fiscal year.
- 9 SECTION 2. (a) Beginning with the 2019-2020 fiscal year
- 10 and each fiscal year thereafter, all departments, agencies, and
- 11 other instrumentalities of the State shall identify positions
- 12 within their jurisdictions that have been vacant for five or
- 13 more years and shall eliminate those positions from their budget
- 14 request for the next fiscal year.
- 15 (b) Any unencumbered funds previously allocated for the
- 16 positions eliminated by this Act shall be deposited to the
- 17 credit of the general fund.



SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
