## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMPUTER SCIENCE EDUCATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) Beginning in the 2022-2023 school year,
- 2 each public elementary school or public charter elementary
- 3 school shall offer instruction in the basics of computer science
- 4 and computational thinking.
- 5 (b) Beginning in the 2023-2024 school year, each public
- 6 middle or intermediate school or public charter middle or
- 7 intermediate school shall offer instruction in exploratory
- 8 computer science.
- 9 (c) To comply with the requirements of this section, a
- 10 computer science course or instruction in computer science
- 11 offered by a public school or public charter school shall:
- 12 (1) Be of high quality, as defined by the board of
- 13 education; and
- 14 (2) Meet or exceed the standards and curriculum
- requirements established by the board of education.
- (d) Each public school and public charter school
- 17 (elementary, middle or intermediate, and high school) shall

- 1 submit an annual report to the department of education that
- 2 lists the computer science courses that are offered that include
- 3 a minimum amount of programming.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

### Report Title:

Computer Science; Department of Education; Middle or Intermediate School; Elementary School; Requirements

### Description:

Beginning in the 2022-2023 school year, requires each public elementary school or public charter elementary school to offer instruction in the basics of computer science and computational thinking. Beginning in the 2023-2024 school year, requires each public middle or intermediate school or public charter middle or intermediate school to offer instruction in exploratory computer science. Establishes reporting requirements.

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
