SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII TO DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT UNDERGRADUATE TEACHER EDUCATION DEGREE PROGRAMS ON EACH NEIGHBOR ISLAND.

1 2 3	WHEREAS, there is a statewide shortage of certified instructors to adequately serve the educational needs of Hawaii's K-12 public school students; and
4 5 6 7 8 9	WHEREAS, five hundred eight emergency hires taught public school students during the 2018-2019 school year, but there were five hundred twenty-one additional vacancies that remained unfilled, reflecting a vacuum in licensed educators; and
9 10 11 12 13 14	WHEREAS, the number of Hawaii education program graduates has declined sharply within the past decade, falling from five hundred forty-four in the 2012-2013 academic year to three hundred eighty in the 2017-2018 academic year; and
15 16 17 18	WHEREAS, Hawaii has demonstrated worsening teacher retention rates, with the number of teachers leaving Hawaii increasing by over seventy percent since 2012; and
19 20 21 22 23	WHEREAS, neighbor island school complexes exhibit some of the highest percentages of emergency hires and vacancies, including thirty-five percent of teachers in Lanai, nineteen percent of teachers in Hana, and fifteen percent of teachers in Molokai; and
24 25 26 27 28	WHEREAS, Hawaii State Approved Teacher Education Programs offering undergraduate degrees have not yet been established on any of the neighbor islands; and
29 30	WHEREAS, offering undergraduate teaching degrees on all the neighbor islands will provide neighbor island students with

equal access to pursuing degrees in teacher education and 1 serving the unique educational needs of their communities; now, 2 3 therefore. 4 5 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of 6 Representatives concurring, that the University of Hawaii is 7 urged to develop and implement undergraduate teacher education 8 9 degree programs on each neighbor island; and 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in formulating neighbor island 11 undergraduate teaching degrees, the University of Hawaii is 12 13 urged to: 14 Gather data from the current population of K-12 public 15 (1)school teachers on the neighbor islands to assess 16 17 subject area needs and capabilities; 18 Establish relationships with the neighbor island 19 (2) complex areas to develop teacher education pathways 20 for high school students to enroll in undergraduate 21 teacher education programs; and 22 23 Expand distance learning opportunities to bolster 24 (3) teacher education opportunities on the neighbor 25 islands; and 26 27 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson and 29 Members of the Board of Regents of the University of Hawaii, 30 President of the University of Hawaii System, Chairperson and 31 Members of the Board of Education, and Superintendent of 32 33 Education. 34 35 36 OFFERED BY:
