SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A TERM, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT COVERING A PORTION OF STATE SUBMERGED LANDS FOR A RUBBLE ROCK REVETMENT, ROCK WALL, AND TWO CONCRETE STAIRWAYS, AND FOR USE, MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, REPLACEMENT, AND REMOVAL OF THE EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED THEREON.

WHEREAS, the existing rubble rock revetment, rock wall, and 1 2 two concrete stairways identified as Tax Map Key: (2) 3-9-005: 3 seaward of 001, Kamaole Beach lots, Kamaole, Kula, Maui, were 4 placed on state submerged lands; and 5 WHEREAS, the Office of Conservation and Coastal Lands 6 7 indicated they had no objection to the retention of the rubble 8 rock revetment, rock wall, and concrete stairways, and that no conservation district violations existed with regard to the 9 10 legally constructed and previously approved structure; and 11 12 WHEREAS, after discussion between the Department of Land and Natural Resources staff and Association of Apartment Owners 13 of Hale Pau Hana ("AOAO") it was agreed by both parties to 14 resolve these encroachments through the issuance of a term non-15 exclusive easement covering the use of state submerged lands by 16 replacing two existing revocable permits; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, the subject encroachments were discovered during a 20 routine site inspection of two revocable permits between the State and AOAO; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS, in addition, one of the revocable permit authorized landscaping on state fast land (state lands mauka of 24 the certified shoreline); and 25 26 WHEREAS, upon reviewing the existing revocable permits, the 27 Department of Land and Natural Resources staff determined that 28 the most appropriate disposition for the subject encroachments 29

and fast lands (landscaped area) would be a fifty-five-year term 1 2 non-exclusive easement; and 3 4 WHEREAS, after discussing the possibility of a long-term 5 easement with the AOAO, it was agreed that a long-term easement would be the appropriate disposition for the subject 6 7 encroachments; and 8 WHEREAS, the subject revetment, rock wall, two stairways, 9 10 and landscaped area encumber an area of 18,668 square feet, more or less, and roughly fifty percent of that area is submerged 11 12 lands and fifty percent fast lands; and 13 14 WHEREAS, the Legislature's approval is only being requested 15 for the submerged portion of the easement; and 16 17 WHEREAS, on March 10, 2011, under agenda item D-4, the 18 Board of Land and Natural Resources approved the issuance of a fifty-five-year term, non-exclusive easement to the AOAO; and 19 20 21 WHEREAS, the grantee has paid the fair market value of the 18,668 square feet non-exclusive easement area of \$291,000, as 22 23 determined by independent appraisal; and 24 25 WHEREAS, section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires 26 the prior approval of the Governor and prior authorization of the Legislature by concurrent resolution to lease state 27 28 submerged lands; now, therefore, 29 30 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of 31 32 Representatives concurring, that the Board of Land and Natural Resources is hereby authorized to issue a term, non-exclusive 33 34 easement covering a portion of state submerged lands fronting 35 the property identified as Tax Map Key: (2) 3-9-005: portion of 36 and seaward of parcel 001, for the use, maintenance, repair, replacement, and removal of existing rock revetment and concrete 37 stairways; and 38 39 40
