SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION TO IMPLEMENT THE USE OF TRAFFIC CALMING SYSTEMS TO REGULATE SPEEDING ON SURFACE STREETS.

WHEREAS, traffic congestion is often cited as a 1 2 contributing factor to aggressive driving, including speeding; 3 and 4 WHEREAS, the increase in traffic congestion and speeding 5 6 throughout the State has increased the risk of harm to drivers, passengers, bicyclists, and pedestrians; and 7 8 WHEREAS, all vehicles, including automobiles, motorcycles, 9 mopeds, and bicycles are capable of speeding; and 10 11 WHEREAS, according to the National Highway Traffic Safety 12 Administration of the United States Department of 13 14 Transportation, speeding was involved in forty-seven percent of all traffic fatalities in Hawaii; and 15 16 WHEREAS, because traffic safety is of paramount importance 17 to residents and visitors alike, implementation of more 18 19 effective methods to regulate speeding and enforce speed limits, 20 including traffic calming systems, is necessary; and 21 22 WHEREAS, traffic calming is a method used to regulate speeding by managing the flow of traffic using physical designs 23 and devices, including narrow lanes, speed bumps, speed tables, 24 25 raised crosswalks and intersections, and roundabouts; now, therefore, 26 27 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature 28 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of 29



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Representatives concurring, that the Department of 1 Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu is 2 requested to consider and take action to implement traffic 3 calming systems to regulate speeding on surface streets 4 throughout Honolulu; and 5 6 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu is 8 also requested to take immediate action to implement traffic 9 10 calming systems in the following locations in Waipahu: 11 Kahuanui Street; and 12 (1) 13 14 (2) The section of Hiapo Street between Mahoe Street and 15 Waipahu Street; and 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 18 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of the 19 Department of Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu. 20 21 22 23
