WHEREAS; the Hawaii Agribusiness Development Corporation and the City and County of Honolulu have noted a significant rise in illegal activity on and around Saipan Drive, including evidence of murder, auto theft, personal property theft, and illegal dumping; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of the Navy is urged to provide security services on Saipan Drive in Whitmore Village on the island of Oahu to prevent illegal activities on land adjacent to a naval facility; and
