## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR TO ESTABLISH A MULTI-STAKEHOLDER TASK FORCE TO ADVANCE STATE PROCUREMENT OF LOCALLY PRODUCED FOOD.

WHEREAS, as the State strives to increase procurement of 1 locally produced food, it is imperative that procedures, 2 3 programs, and infrastructure be developed to enable all of 4 Hawaii's farmers to participate in the state procurement 5 process; and 6 7 WHEREAS, local food hubs, agricultural cooperatives, and similar entities play a key role in aggregation products to 8 9 volumes that promote institutional purchasing and distribution, as well as providing services such as quality control; and 10 11 12 WHEREAS, state purchasing from local food hubs and 13 agricultural cooperatives supports the State's goals of increased local food production, food security, and agricultural 14 15 self-sufficiency; and 16 17 WHEREAS, linking local farms to state departments and agencies not only increases the State's collective capacity for 18 food production, but connects communities with the āina, 19 20 improves public health, develops an educated agricultural workforce, and enriches the local food system and environment; 21 22 and 23 24 WHEREAS, a successful farm-to-state program has the potential to increase local food production to fuel the 25 evolution of the local farming sector into a thriving small 26 business sector that generates safe commercial food volumes and 27 28 increases the communities' resiliency and capacity to create jobs; now, therefore, 29 30 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature 31 32 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of



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Representatives concurring, that the Office of the Lieutenant 1 2 Governor is requested to establish a multi-stakeholder task force to advance the state procurement of locally produced food 3 4 with key partners, including the State Procurement Office, Department of Education's 'Aina Pono, food hub operators and 5 6 family farmers, Department of Agriculture, Department of Health, 7 and distributors and groups that advocate for family farmers; 8 and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force is requested to develop a framework to address: 11 12 (1)Increasing regional sourcing of local food through 13 14 food hubs, cooperatives, and family farmers; 15 16 (2)Measuring the number of family farm livelihoods that benefit from purchases of locally produced foods by 17 the farm-to-state program; 18 19 (3) Establishing mechanisms to promote contracts with 20 producers and ensure timely payments for local food 21 22 acquired by the State; 23 (4) Purchasing directly from family farmers and food hubs; 24 25 (5) Identifying supports and resources needed to develop, 26 27 expand, and connect Hawaii's local food production and 28 distribution; and 29 A clear and flexible structure and interface for 30 (6) exclusively-local food operators; and 31 32 33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 34 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Lieutenant 35 Governor, Chief Procurement Officer, Chairperson of the Board of Education, Superintendent of Education, Chairperson of the Board 36 of Agriculture, Director of Health, President of the Hawai'i Farm 37 Bureau, and President of the Hawai'i Farmers Union United. 38 39 40 41 OFFERED BY:



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
