SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO UPDATE AND REPORT ON TRANSIT-ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTATION FOR THE KAKAAKO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, construction of the City and County of Honolulu's 1 rail transit system is underway, with an anticipated completion 2 date of December 2025; and 3 4 WHEREAS, once completed, the rail transit system will help 5 address Honolulu's transportation needs while creating 6 development opportunities for all types of housing within 7 8 Honolulu's urban core; and 9 WHEREAS, transit-oriented development supports rail 10 ridership goals by locating denser, mixed-use developments along 11 the rail transit line; encouraging orderly growth; and improving 12 accessibility around rail stations and within Honolulu's urban 13 core; and 14 15 16 WHEREAS, transit-oriented development areas are typically located within one to two miles of a rail station; and 17 18 WHEREAS, increasing the supply of all types of housing 19 20 within transit-oriented development areas will aid in preventing further urban sprawl and use of non-urban lands to meet 21 Honolulu's housing needs; and 22 23 24 WHEREAS, transit-oriented development requires the quidance of plans that address issues relating to land use, circulation, 25 26 urban design, housing, community facilities, pedestrian amenities, historic and cultural enhancements, and 27 infrastructure and can be aligned with general development 28 29 plans; and



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WHEREAS, transit-oriented development plans often include 1 various incentives, including allowances for more extensive and 2 varied uses of land and increased building height and density, 3 to provide community benefits and amenities appropriate for 4 properties within walking distance to a rail station; and 5 6 7 WHEREAS, much of the land within the Hawaii Community Development Authority's Kakaako Community Development District 8 is located within a one-mile radius of a rail station; and 9 10 WHEREAS, although the City and County of Honolulu has 11 developed transit-oriented development rules for certain lands 12 within areas surrounding rail stations, these rules do not apply 13 to lands within the Kakaako Community Development District; and 14 15 WHEREAS, lands within the Kakaako Community Development 16 District would benefit from a transit-oriented development plan 17 to direct and manage growth around the district's rail station, 18 expand the types of allowable uses, provide development 19 incentives, stimulate development activity around the district's 20 rail station, encourage development of all types of housing, and 21 increase ridership on the rail transit system; and 22 23 WHEREAS, THE Hawaii Community Development Authority has 24 accepted a final environmental impact statement and adopted a 25 transit-oriented development overlay plan; now, therefore, 26 27 28 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of 29 30 Representatives concurring, that the Hawaii Community Development Authority is requested to update the transit-31 32 oriented development overlay plan as needed to complement the adjacent transit-oriented development plans of the City and 33 34 County of Honolulu; and 35 36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii Community Development Authority is requested to submit a copy of the 37 38 updated transit-oriented development overlay plan for the Kakaako Community Development District, including any proposed 39 40 amendments to the Hawaii Administrative Rules, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 41 42 the Regular Session of 2022; and
