REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII TO EXPLORE AN OPTIONAL DINING PROGRAM FOR RESIDENCE HALL STUDENTS.

12	WHEREAS, instead of allowing these residence hall students
13	to have an optional meal plan, they must seek out alternate
14	housing; and

16	WHEREAS, campus dining plans add to the already high cost
17	of attending the University of Hawaii; and

19	WHEREAS, students who reside in residence halls should be
20	given the option whether they wish to participate in the dining
21	program or not, similar to apartment residents, without being
22	forced to seek out alternative housing arrangements; now,
