## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO AMEND THE UNITED STATES CODE TO PERMIT ALL RETIRED, DISABLED VETERANS TO RECEIVE CONCURRENT RETIREMENT AND DISABILITY PAYMENTS.

WHEREAS, under federal law, the phrase "concurrent 1 retirement and disability payments" refers to a retired, 2 disabled veteran's simultaneous receipt of the veteran's full 3 4 retirement payments and disability compensation; and 5 WHEREAS, prior to implementation of the concurrent 6 7 retirement and disability payments program, the retirement payments for all retired, disabled veterans were offset by the 8 9 amount of disability compensation received by the veteran; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the National Defense Authorization Act of Fiscal Year 2004 amended 10 United States Code section 1414 to permit 12 13 retired, disabled veterans who served in the armed forces for twenty or more years and have a United States Department of 14 Veterans Affairs disability rating at or above fifty percent to 15 receive concurrent retirement and disability payments; and 16 17 18 WHEREAS, however, the retirement payments for retired, 19 disabled veterans who are ineligible for concurrent retirement and disability payments continue to be offset by the amount of 20 21 disability compensation received by the veteran; and 22 23 WHEREAS, in 2017, the Congressional Budget Office estimated that the annual cost to provide concurrent retirement and 24 25 disability payments was \$11,400,000,000; and 26 WHEREAS, the Congressional Budget Office also estimated 27 that providing concurrent retirement and disability payments to 28 29 retired veterans having a disability rating below fifty percent 30 would cost approximately \$30,000,000,000 over a ten-year period,

and providing concurrent retirement and disability payments to retired, disabled veterans having less than twenty years of service in the armed forces would cost approximately \$5,800,000,000 over a ten-year period; now, therefore, \$5

6 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of 7 8 Representatives concurring, that the United States Congress is urged to amend 10 United States Code section 1414 to permit all 9 retired American veterans who have a service-connected 10 disability to receive concurrent retirement and disability 11 payments regardless of the veteran's disability rating or years 12 of service in the armed forces; and 13

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 16 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Majority Leader of 17 the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House 18 of Representatives, and each member of Hawaii's Congressional 19 Delegation.
