## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT, UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII, AND DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO CONVENE A TASK FORCE TO IDENTIFY AND CREATE A CONSISTENT METHOD FOR STREAMLINING JOB POSTINGS FOR POSITIONS WITHIN THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII AND DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

WHEREAS, while Hawaii has one of the lowest unemployment 1 rates in the nation, there are still many vacancies not being 2 filled throughout the public sector, including positions within 3 the University of Hawaii System and Department of Education; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the Department of Human Resources Development 6 maintains a centralized online database of available employment 7 opportunities for various state departments and agencies; and 8 9 WHEREAS, some state entities, such as the University of 10 Hawaii and Department of Education, each post job openings on 11 their respective websites, which may create inconsistencies in 12 job descriptions and other relevant information; and 13 14 WHEREAS, inconsistencies may further exist as to how job 15 postings are communicated to potential applicants which can 16 further delay vacancies from being filled; and 17 18 WHEREAS, to ensure that state departments and agencies are 19 effectively recruiting qualified applicants for vacant 20 positions, it is critical that current job posting practices be 21 reviewed to better streamline the process across all departments 22 and agencies; now, therefore, 23 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature 25 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of 26 Representatives concurring, that the Department of Human 27 Resources Development, University of Hawaii, and Department of 28 Education are requested to convene a task force to identify and 29 create a consistent method for streamlining job postings for 30
