SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE PURCHASE OF EMERGENCY EVACUATION CHAIRS FOR DISTRIBUTION AND INSTALLATION IN EVERY STATE BUILDING HAVING TWO OR MORE FLOORS.

WHEREAS, sixty-one million adults in the United States live 1 2 with a disability; and 3 WHEREAS, nearly sixteen percent of adults in Hawaii have 4 5 some type of disability, including nearly eight percent who have significant mobility issues; and 6 7 8 WHEREAS, mobility disabilities often include conditions 9 requiring the use of one or more devices, such as canes, 10 crutches, wheelchairs, or scooters, to maneuver through an 11 environment; and 12 13 WHEREAS, mobility disabilities also often include other ambulatory mobility issues such as the use of walkers, braces, 14 15 artificial limbs, or orthopedic shoes, as well as respiratory issues and partial or total vision loss; and 16 17 WHEREAS, pursuant to section 107-25, Hawaii Revised 18 19 Statutes, all buildings in the State are required to comply with 20 various building and design codes, including the state fire code as adopted by the State Fire Council; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS, in many emergency situations, including fires, 24 elevators are often an unsafe and unreliable evacuation option; 25 and 26 27 WHEREAS, vertical evacuation, or evacuation via stairway, 28 is often the preferred method of egress in emergency situations; 29 and 30 31 WHEREAS, Hawaii does not currently require that state 32 buildings provide emergency evacuation devices to assist in the



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vertical evacuation of personnel or visitors with mobility 1 2 disabilities or impairments; and 3 WHEREAS, emergency evacuation chairs are folding chairs 4 5 that allow people with permanent or temporary mobility limitations to be safely moved downstairs or upstairs during an 6 7 emergency; and 8 9 WHEREAS, placing an emergency evacuation chair at or near a 10 stairwell on each floor of every state building will enhance the 11 safety of persons with mobility impairments who work in or otherwise utilize state buildings; now, therefore, 12 13 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature 14 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of 15 Representatives concurring, that the Department of Accounting 16 and General Services is urged to purchase, distribute, and 17 18 install emergency evacuation chairs in every state building 19 having two or more floors; and 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Accounting 21 22 and General Services is urged to install, at minimum, one emergency evacuation chair at or near a stairwell on each floor, 23 except the floor of exit discharge, of every state building 24 having two or more floors, provided that each emergency 25 26 evacuation chair is installed and stored in compliance with the 27 state fire code: and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for the purpose of this 30 Concurrent Resolution, "state building" means a building that is under the management and control of any state department; and 31 32 33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that every emergency evacuation 34 chair purchased in accordance with this Concurrent Resolution 35 should be capable of ascending and descending stairs; and 36 37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Accounting and General Services, in procuring any emergency evacuation 38 chair or other product necessary to carry out the purposes of 39 40 this Concurrent Resolution, is urged to do so in accordance with chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes; and 41 42



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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Accounting 1 2 and General Services is urged to maintain a current and accurate list of all the emergency evacuation chairs in circulation 3 pursuant to this Concurrent Resolution and to perform yearly 4 inspections to ensure the safe placement and function of each 5 6 chair; and 7

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Disability Communication 8 9 and Access Board, in cooperation with the Department of 10 Accounting and General Services, is urged to conduct annual training to explain the purpose and appropriate safe use of 11 emergency evacuation chairs for relevant personnel from each 12 13 state building in which at least one emergency evacuation chair 14 is installed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Disability Communication 16 and Access Board is urged to produce informational material 17 describing the purpose, placement, and appropriate use of 18 emergency evacuation chairs for distribution to the occupants of 19 20 each state building in which an emergency evacuation chair is 21 installed; and 22

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 23 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, 24 Comptroller, Executive Director of the Disability and 25 26 Communication Access Board, and each member of the State Fire 27 Council.
