SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION TO CONDUCT A REVENUE LOSS ANALYSIS OF MEDICAL AND GROCERY EXCISE TAX EXEMPTIONS FOR RETIRED SENIOR CITIZENS AGED SIXTY YEARS AND OLDER.

1 WHEREAS, many retired senior citizens aged sixty years and older live on fixed incomes and must live on a tight budget, 2 requiring that the purchase of discretionary goods or services 3 be limited or curtailed; and 4 5 WHEREAS, expenses that cannot be easily limited or 6 7 curtailed include groceries and medical services; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the gap between the costs of these expenses and the fixed incomes of retired senior citizens tend to widen over 10 time, making it increasingly difficult for a retired senior 11 citizen to budget accordingly; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS, proactive measures must be taken so that retired senior citizens can maintain a reasonable quality of life and 15 16 afford the increasing costs of groceries and medical services; now, therefore, 17 18 19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, that the 20 Department of Taxation is requested to conduct a revenue loss 21 22 analysis of medical and grocery excise tax exemptions for 23 retired senior citizens aged sixty years and older; and 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Taxation is 25 26 requested to submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation to implement 27 the general excise tax exemption, to the Legislature no later 28 29 than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2021; and 30
