SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO CONDUCT A STUDY ON AUGMENTING, INCREASING, AND EXPANDING AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, the after school programs of the Department of 1 Education are an important resource for working families and 2 provide a safe, enjoyable, and educational venue for students 3 between the end of the school day and when they can rejoin their 4 family and caregivers; and 5 6 WHEREAS, the after school programs of the Department of 7 Education include After-School Plus (A+); Resources for 8 Enrichment, Athletics, Culture, and Health (REACH); and Uniting 9 Peer Learning, Integrating New Knowledge (UPLINK); and 10 11 WHEREAS, while A+, REACH, and UPLINK are all worthy 12 programs, more can be done; and 13 14 WHEREAS, diverse and effective after school programs can 15 help to achieve a number of important social goals; and 16 17 WHEREAS, increased monetary support for after school 18 programs serving underprivileged youth can assist overworked, 19 low-income families who cannot afford babysitters; and 20 21 WHEREAS, after school programs help to occupy students 22 during the hours of the day in which they are more likely to 23 engage in criminal activity, experiment with illegal substances 24 and alcohol, or become the victim of crime; and 25 26 WHEREAS, a revitalization and expansion of after school 27 programs can help Hawaii to prevent the occurrence of teen 28 suicide and attempted suicide rather than to continue suffering 29 from one of the highest rates in the nation; and 30 31 WHEREAS, curriculum can be implemented in after school 32 programs to inspire youth to do and be more; and 33 34



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WHEREAS, improved after school programs can help expose the 1 youth of Hawaii on the wide variety of career opportunities 2 available to them across the globe; and 3 4 WHEREAS, teenagers in particular could be supported with 5 opportunities for learning life skills such as money management, 6 how to build credit, financial literacy, and entrepreneurship 7 basics; and 8 9 WHEREAS, diverse after school programming can help youth 10 discover what sparks their passion; now, therefore, 11 12 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature 13 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, that the 14 Department of Education is urged to conduct a study on how after 15 school programs may be augmented, increased, or expanded, and 16 submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including 17 any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than 18 twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 19 2021; and 20 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 22 Resolution be transmitted to Chairperson of the Board of 23 Education and Superintendent of Education. 24 25 26 27 OFFERED BY: Hurt terella 2 2020-1600 SR SMA.doc

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
