SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO ESTABLISH ADVANCE TRAVEL QUARANTINE AND STATEWIDE STAY-AT-HOME ORDERS TO ENSURE RAPID AND EFFECTIVE RESPONSE TO ANY RESURGENCE OF THE CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 IN HAWAII.

WHEREAS, the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) may 1 continue to endanger the health, safety, and welfare of Hawaii 2 residents and visitors for the foreseeable future; and 3 4 WHEREAS, any response to a COVID-19 resurgence requires 5 serious attention, effort, coordination, and sacrifice to avert 6 unmanageable or catastrophic strains on the State's health care 7 system and other industries; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, both residents and travelers to the State have a vital role in ensuring the effectiveness of a quarantine; and 11 12 WHEREAS, any traveler entering the State or traveling 13 14 between the islands who is unable or refuses to comply with any guarantine restriction related to COVID-19 is a danger to the 15 State's residents and visitors; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the current fourteen-day self-quarantine mandate 18 for travelers entering the State and traveling between the 19 islands has been an important means of reducing the spread of 20 COVID-19 and saving lives in the State; and 21 22 WHEREAS, as the State begins to relax initial restrictions 23 related to COVID-19, a self-quarantine mandate for travelers and 24 a statewide stay-at-home order that can be deployed swiftly and 25 effectively will be critical to ensure the safety and health of 26 the people of Hawaii in the event of a COVID-19 resurgence; now, 27 therefore, 28 29 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature 30 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, that the 31 Governor is requested to establish advance travel quarantine and 32



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statewide stay-at-home orders to ensure rapid and effective 1 response to any future resurgence of COVID-19 in the State; and 2 3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any mandatory travel quarantine 4 order is requested to include a requirement that any traveler 5 who is unwilling or unable to comply with the order be subject 6 to mandatory imprisonment or immediate transport back to the 7 traveler's last departure location at the traveler's expense; 8 9 and 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any travel quarantine order is 11 12 requested to include both civil and criminal penalties for any person found to be in violation of the order; and 13 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any travel quarantine order 15 drafted pursuant to this Resolution is requested to include both 16 civil and criminal penalties for any person found guilty of 17 aiding another in violating a travel quarantine order; and 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any statewide stay-at-home 20 order is requested to also include both civil and criminal 21 penalties for any person found to be in violation of the 22 23 statewide stay-at-home order; and 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 26 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Attorney General, and 27 Adjutant General. 28 29 30 31
