## SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO BROADEN THE CONTENT OF THE SOCIAL SCIENCE CURRICULUM TO INCLUDE VARIOUS PRINCIPLES OF DIVERSITY.

WHEREAS, teaching principles of diversity prepares students 1 2 to be global citizens by exposing them to different cultures and social groups; and 3 4 WHEREAS, exposure to principles of diversity allows 5 students to be prepared to work in settings and situations with 6 7 various groups of people; and 8 9 WHEREAS, studies show that students feel safer in and out 10 of school when they receive an education that includes a variety of diverse perspectives; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, learning about different social, ethnic, and 14 religious cultures allows students to become comfortable with cultural differences across social groups and comfortable with 15 their own identity; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the Department of Education has made great strides 18 19 to include principles of diversity in its social science curriculum to more accurately reflect the roles of women and 20 different racial and ethnic groups in society and throughout 21 history; and 22 23 24 WHEREAS, being educated about diversity increases cultural competence and reduces discriminatory stereotyping; and 25 26 27 WHEREAS, our community as a whole will greatly benefit from 28 enhancing our cultural competence to include gender, sexual 29 orientation, and religion; and 30 WHEREAS, the Department of Education's anchor standard 31 SS.9-12.5.1, highlights the importance for students to identify 32 33 local, regional, and global problems and issues using interdisciplinary lenses; now, therefore, 34 35



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1 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, that the 2 Department of Education is urged to include social issues and 3 historical perspectives of gender identity, sexual orientation, 4 5 and religious practices in its social science curriculum; and 6
