SENATE RESOLUTION

CONVENING A RESTAURANT REOPENING TASK FORCE TO ASSIST IN THE SAFE REOPENING OF RESTAURANTS THROUGHOUT THE STATE THAT WERE CLOSED DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

WHEREAS, the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic 1 2 created an unprecedented public health crisis that has caused significant physical, mental, emotional, and economic harm to 3 the State and its residents; and 4 5 WHEREAS, restaurants are an important part of the State's 6 economy and employed nearly eighty-five thousand individuals in 7 8 2019: and 9 10 WHEREAS, restaurant and other food service employees continue to provide crucial services to the people of Hawaii and 11 deserve protection against COVID-19; and 12 13 WHEREAS, restaurant customers also require protection from 14 15 COVID-19 while patronizing Hawaii's restaurants; and 16 WHEREAS, in response to COVID-19, the United States Food 17 and Drug Administration and National Restaurant Association have 18 developed recommended best practices and safety quidelines for 19 restaurants; and 20 21 WHEREAS, owners preparing to reopen restaurants may require 22 23 additional guidance on adopting and implementing these recommended best practices and safety guidelines; now, 24 therefore, 25 26 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature 27 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, that a 28 Restaurant Reopening Task Force be convened to assist in the 29 safe reopening of restaurants throughout the State that were 30 closed due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and 31 32
