Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 1191, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO MINIMUM WAGE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to increase the minimum wage to combat rising wage disparity and incentivize greater provision of healthcare to lower wage employees by their employers.

Specifically, beginning January 1, 2020, this measure increases minimum wage rates annually and also establishes a separate minimum wage rate scale that provides annual increases at lower minimum wage rates for employees who receive employersponsored health benefits under the Hawaii Prepaid Health Care Act.
