begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to adjust and make additional appropriations for operating costs of the Executive Branch for fiscal biennium 2019-2021.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Department of Human Services, Department of Health, University of Hawaii System, Ke Ao Hali'i, and The Trust for Public Land. Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Department of Education, Department of Accounting and General Services, Department of Land and Natural Resources, Department of Hawaiian Home Lands, Department of Transportation, Department of Agriculture, Hawaii Public Housing Authority, Early Learning Board, Hawaii State Public Library System, Hawaii Health Systems Corporation, and Executive Office on Early Learning.
