Your Committees on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and Health and Agriculture and Environment, to which was referred H.B. No. 2718, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO CLIMATE CHANGE MITIGATION AND ADAPTATION,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to establish and appropriate funds for a Climate Change and Human Health Adaptation Coordinator within the Department of Health and related operating expenses.

Your Committees received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Health, Department of Agriculture, Office of Planning, Hawaii Climate Change Mitigation and Adaptation Commission, one member of the Hawaiii County Council, County of Hawaiii Planning Department, Honolulu Board of Water Supply, Hawaiii Public Health Association, and three individuals. Your Committees received testimony in opposition to this measure from one individual.

Your Committees find that climate change affects human health and well-being and is a critical public health problem. While investments in mitigation relating to infrastructure to reduce carbon emissions or prepare for sea level rise are sound, there

has been insufficient activity focusing on adaptation, specifically for human health. Additionally, climate change makes many existing diseases and conditions worse and may also help introduce new pests and pathogens into new regions or communities. The most vulnerable people, such as children, the elderly, the poor, and those with underlying health conditions, are at increased risk for health effects from climate change, all of which will begin to further stress the health care infrastructure, financial systems, and delivery systems. This measure ensures that there is statewide coordination and planning in the implementation of adaptation goals, principles, and policies relating to climate change impacts on human health.

Your Committees have amended this measure by:

- (1) Inserting an appropriation amount of \$165,000 for fiscal year 2020-2021 for the establishment of one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) permanent Climate Change and Human Health Adaptation Coordinator position and other operating expenses; and
- (2) Inserting an effective date of July 1, 2020.

As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your Committees on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and Health and Agriculture and Environment that are attached to this report, your Committees are in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 2718, H.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommend that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 2718, H.D. 1, S.D. 1, and be referred to your Committee on Ways and Means.
