"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO GOVERNMENT DATA,"

The purpose of this measure is to establish a Chief Data Officer and a Data Task Force in the Office of Enterprise Technology to develop, implement, and manage statewide data policies, procedures, and standards; and to facilitate data sharing across state agencies.

The Department of Education, Office of Enterprise Technology Services, Civil Beat Law Center for the Public Interest, Ulupono Initiative, Transform Hawai'i Government, and Hawaii Advocates for Consumer Rights testified in support of this measure. The Office of Information Practices provided comments.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2112, to promote further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.
