"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO LEASEHOLD CONDOMINIUMS ON LANDS CONTROLLED BY THE STATE,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- Authorize the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation (HHFDC) to enter into maximum seventy-five year leases with qualified residents for units in condominiums developed on state land;
- (2) Exempt state lands set aside by the Governor for HHFDC or state lands leased to HHFDC and upon which leasehold condominium units are developed from the definition of public land; and
- (3) Require legislative approval for the sale or gift of such lands upon which leasehold condominium units are developed.
