Your Committee on Public Safety, Intergovernmental, and  
Military Affairs, to which was referred S.B. No. 1264 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE  
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to provide  
emergency funding for temporary housing for 248 inmates at Halawa  
Correctional Facility.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure  
from the Department of Public Safety.

Your Committee finds that funding for the temporary housing  
of the 248 inmates terminated in December 2018. Your Committee  
additionally finds that funding to cover the costs of housing 248  
inmates at an out-of-state facility for the remaining six months  
of fiscal year 2019 is necessary while security electronics and  
hardware repairs and improvements at Halawa Correctional Facility  
are being completed.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your  
Committee on Public Safety, Intergovernmental, and Military  
Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee is in  
accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 1264 and recommends  
that it pass Second Reading and be referred to your Committee on  
Ways and Means.
