Your Committee on Water and Land, to which was referred
S.C.R. No. 35 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A
TERM, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT COVERING A PORTION OF STATE
SUBMERGED LANDS AT WAIOHULI-KEOKEA HOMESTEADS AND BEACH LOTS,
KIHEI, MAUI, FOR THE EXISTING SEAWALL AND ROCK REVETMENT, AND
FOR USE, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE OF THE EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS
CONSTRUCTED THEREON,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to authorize the
issuance of a term, non-exclusive easement covering a portion of
state submerged lands fronting the property identified as Tax Map
Key: (2) 3-9-010:seaward of 006, Waiohuli-Keokea Homestead and
Beach Lots, Kihei, Maui, for the existing seawall and rock
revetment and for use, repair, and maintenance of the existing
improvements constructed thereon pursuant to section 171-53,
Hawaii Revised Statutes.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Department of Land and Natural Resources.

Your Committee finds that, pursuant to section 171-53, Hawaii
Revised Statutes, the Board of Land and Natural Resources may
lease submerged lands with the prior approval of the Governor and
the prior authorization of the Legislature by concurrent
resolution. Your Committee further finds that on July 11, 2014,

under agenda item D-3, the Board of Land and Natural Resources approved a grant of a fifty-five year, non-exclusive easement to resolve the encroachment of the existing seawall and rock revetment identified in this measure. Your Committee notes that the grantee has paid the fair market value of the easement. Your Committee concludes that the easement is necessary for the maintenance and repair of the existing seawall and rock revetment and for the use, repair, and maintenance of the existing improvements thereon.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Water and Land that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 35 and recommends its adoption.
